In December 2021, village volunteers got together to help remove an accumulation of logs which had floated downstream, causing an obstruction on the bend of the river, affecting the flow and resulted in an erosion of the opposite river bank.

With the approval of the Parish Council, an expert Arborist and Tree Surgeon, who provided all the specialised equipment, led and guided the team of volunteers.

The work was completed and the meadow left tidy in just one day, saving our village thousands of pounds.
